

PATIENT PAYMENT RESPONSIBILITY

ASSIGNMENT OF INSURANCE BENEFITS AND PAYMENT GUARANTEE

In consideration of services provided, I hereby assign and transfer to Sinai Urgent Care any and all rights, which I have against insurance companies or third-party payors, for payment of charges for services provided by Sinai Urgent Care to me or to one of my dependents. I authorize said payments to be applied to any unpaid balance for which I am responsible.

I understand that I am responsible for and will pay the portion of my bill not covered by insurance companies or third-party payors. I agree to pay the account in full upon receipt of my billing statement unless payment arrangements are made with Sinai Urgent Care. If my account is placed with a collection agency, an additional 35% will be added to my balance.

INSURANCE & MEDICARE PATIENTS

Insurance companies and Medicare set reimbursement amounts for medical providers. These reimbursement amounts are paid the same for each specialty. Co-payment (also known as co-pays), co-insurance and deductibles are the amounts an insured person is responsible to pay for medical expenses. These patient responsibilities are an amount set by your insurance company or Medicare - Sinai Urgent Care does not set or control your patient payment responsibility.

Sinai Urgent Care is bound by federal law to collect co-pays in full at the time of each visit. Failure to do so is considered insurance fraud. Follow-up visits, even if it is for the same complaint, will also be charged a co-pay as this is considered an office visit and is deducted from our reimbursement from insurance companies and Medicare.

If your insurance coverage does not require a co-pay, then Sinai Urgent Care may require you to pay a fee for your visit for co-insurance or towards your deductible. These funds may not represent the entire patient responsibility for your visit. Should the insurance company or Medicare determine that an additional amount is owed, then you will receive an invoice for the outstanding balance, due immediately.

SELF PAY PATIENTS

For those patients without insurance, Sinai Urgent Care has a comprehensive list of medical services and pricing. Before agreeing to receive treatment or a diagnostic test, it is your responsibility to inform our staff that you are a self-pay patient and to request this list of our services.

All co-pays, co-insurance, deductibles, self-pay fees or outstanding balances owed are due at the time of service.
